TRACE Public Information Event on «Energy Efficient Buildings»

The Administrative Department for European and National Funds of the Municipality of Piraeus organised a public information day on Energy Efficient Buildings, which took place on the 10th of December 2014 from 9:00 am to 14:00 pm in the premises of the Piraeus Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

The opening speech was held by Mr. Alexandros Argoudelis, Deputy Mayor of Technical services and infrastructure Networks of the Municipality of Piraeus, while the Centre for Renewable Energy Sources and Saving (CRES) was represented by Mr. Konstantinos Sioulas. During the event the most important outcomes of the TRACE project, as well as other energy upgrading projects for buildings and public spaces in the area of Piraeus were presented to the specialist and non-specialist public. In the second part of the event, experts presented the available funding and financing tools, which aim to enable and promote the energy upgrading of buildings from private companies, as well as public administrations.

The InfoDay was organised within the framework of the SEE-TRACE project (Transnational cooperation for the improvement of buildings energy performance and efficiency), which is co-funded by the European Union and by national funds. TRACE is implemented by a consortium consisting of 13 partners from 9 countries, while Greece is represented by the Municipality of Piraeus as the leading partner and CRES. The project was initiated in November 2012 and is heading today towards its completion.
